UCSA generally sponsors the following activities. As with all UCSA activities, church standards of dress and behavior always apply. Divorces must be final. Mid-Single Adults ages 31-45 are also welcome. The usual schedule is as follows:

FIRESIDES: Usually two firesides a month. *NEW* UCSA will sponsor a monthly online fireside via Zoom starting in October.

DANCES: Usually two dances a month, possibly special occasion dances for General Conference and/or holidays.

TEMPLE: Usually held Quarterly at Provo Temple. The Payson Coordinating Council usually sponsors a monthly breakfast followed by sealing ordinances at the Payson Temple.

CHOIR: Concert firesides usually for Christmas, Easter, and Pops Concert in August. All choir concerts are free and open to the general public to allow family and friends of the choir to attend.
